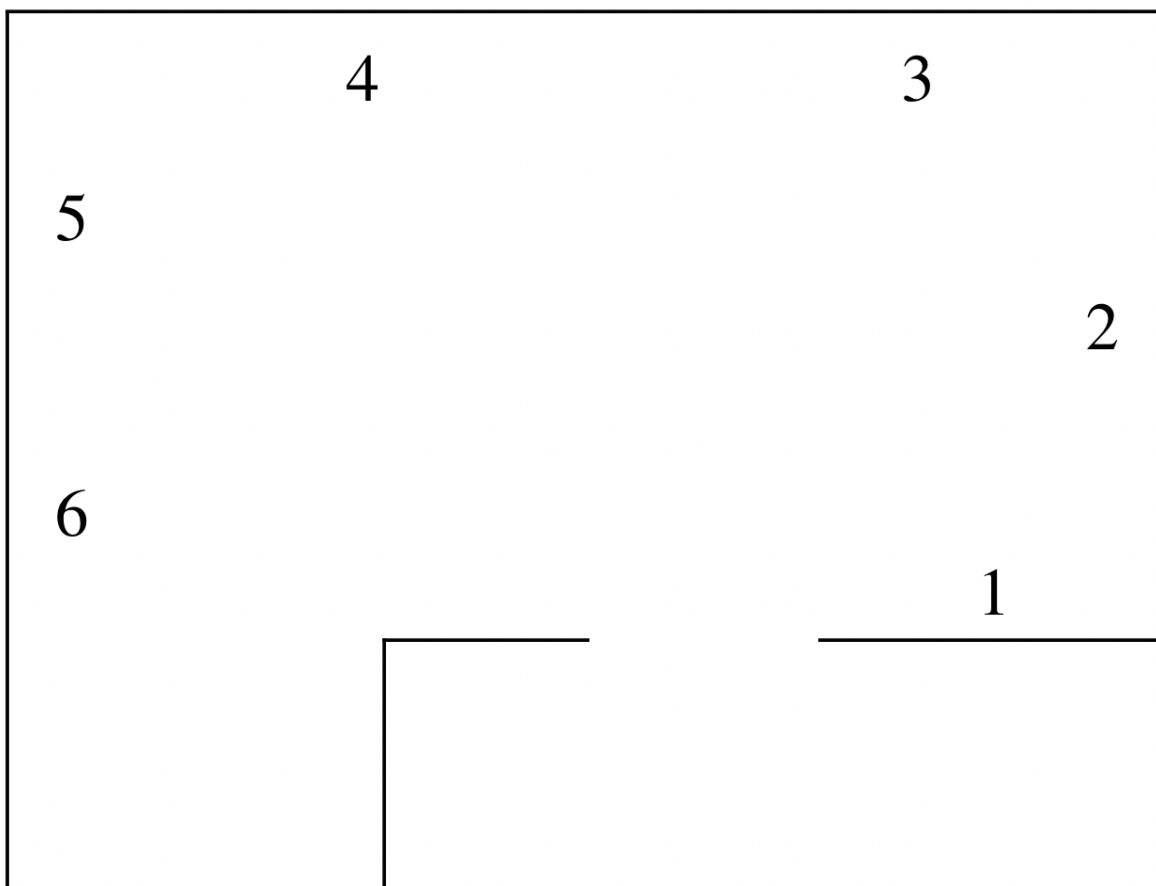
Meets Moss

nap is pleased to present *Meets Moss*, a solo exhibition by artist Colette Stubbings. The exhibition features documentation of ephemeral, sensory explorations born from a methodical process of binding botanical, armor-like hand pieces. Through performed gestures, the pieces are animated and the body becomes a vehicle for material introduction. Textural hues are illuminated on film, and condensed montage translates unwonted sound and detail offered in these private moments of environmental exchange.

Colette Stubbings is an interdisciplinary visual artist based on the traditional land of the Musqueam, Squamish and Tsleil-Waututh First Nations, otherwise known as Vancouver, BC. Inspired by the vibrancies and spirited shapes of plants and creatures from her childhood, Colette's work seeks to realize a restorative relationship with life forms other than her own.
