Afternoon Projects is pleased to present *Sun Warms My Cheek*, a two person exhibition organized by Paul Daunais and Benny Xu, featuring painting and sculptural works from Steffen Sornpao and Addison Willis.

Does the experience of subjection to the body and to the earth become any more pleasing when ensnared by love and empathy? Are we still not bound to what we are and where we exist? I stare into the sky and day dream while the sun warms my cheek, like a kiss from a warden.

The works selected depict a conflicting sense of longing and desire towards its superior, the uncertain nature of the subjects' relationship to its maker allows for a bittersweet sense of confinement, and of love - that is at once benevolent, malevolent, and neutral.

Steffen Sornpao is an artist living and working in Atlanta, Georgia. Along with his practice he also runs the project space Good Enough.

Addison Willis is a visual artist living in Chattanooga, Tennessee. Past exhibitions of his work include 'Opaque Poetics' (Wysing Arts Centre, Cambridgeshire), 'The Fates' (Interstate Projects, Brooklyn).
